3. Knowledge sharing/ Research collaboration

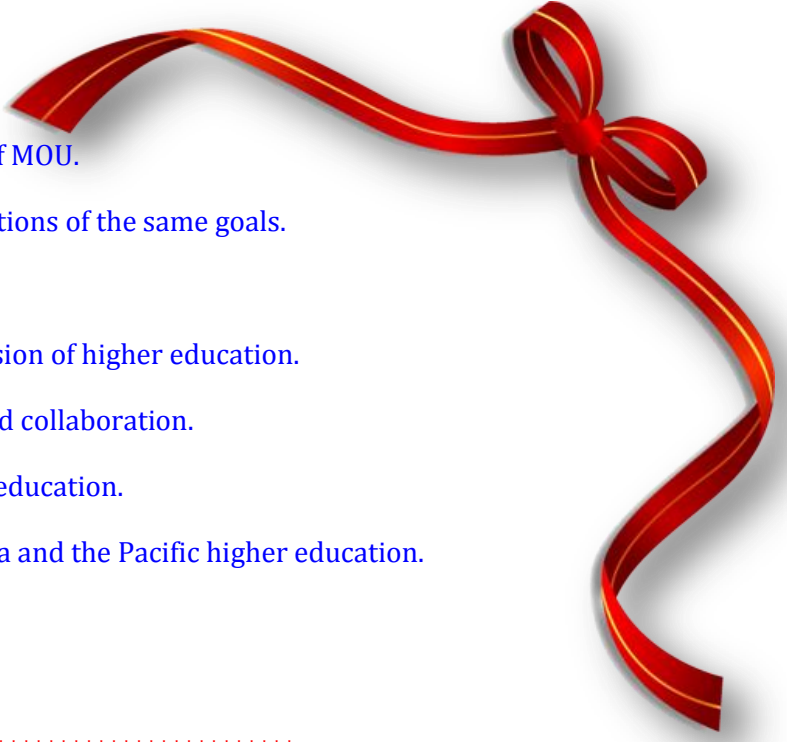
Duration: 2 Years
